ROOF REPAIRS UPDATE



With the erection of scaffolding inside the Church, there is now restrictive use of the Church. Please <u>exercise caution when moving around the Church</u>. During the week [Monday to Friday except Thursday], we will need to vacate the Church immediately at the end of Mass to allow the work to continue. Your co-operation will be greatly appreciated. The roofers plan to have a break whilst Mass

[9.30am-10.00am] is celebrated. There will be no work done over the Weekend, but scaffolding will still be in place so some areas will still be out of bounds. Scaffolding will also be in place in the Nursery Garden so a section of the Car Park will be cornered off as a Nursery Play Area. Once works commence we will have a better idea of what will be happening. We will keep you informed. It is hoped weather and other factors permitting that work should be completed by the beginning of September. After the works are completed the Church will not look different but we will be water tight so no more buckets, papers and towels will be seen around the Church. We will aim to keep disruption to a minimum and thank you in advance for your patience and co-operation during this time. Please see noticeboard for photos of repairs to be done. Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults [RCIA]


