THEME: Some People to Be Shunned?



The message of today is that the Lord Jesus touched with his healing power even the untouchable. Today let each of us reflect on how often in life Jesus has touched us. He touched us with his love in baptism when he saved us from our isolation and gave us the Christian community to live in. He touched us each time he came to us in the Eucharist to speak to us and give us his body. He touched us often with his healing forgiveness, with his consolation in moments

of distress, with his strength when we are timid, with his wisdom when we are confused. But do we let him touch us? And do we touch one another with healing care?

MEDITATE: This short and seemingly simple story is filled with food for reflection for us.

<u>ACT</u>: In your own life, follow Jesus' example with the person in the story. Reach out to someone who may feel marginalized or may be suffering.
