On the feast of Pentecost [28th May] we celebrate our "Unity in Diversity" and the different Nationalities that are part of our Parish. Please come in your National Costume if possible. Tickets on sale after Mass: Adults: £10; Senior Citizens & Children over 12 years: £5. Children under 12 years free. [All children must be accompanied by parent or guardian.] The

money raised will go towards the Church Refurbishment Fund.

FLAGS: A sheet is provided [at the back of the Church] for you to write your country of origin. We will use the information to ensure that we have flags representing all the different parts of the world that make up our community.

INTERNATIONAL CUISINE: As in the past, we are asking people to provide National Dishes. Currently, we have: Jerk Chicken, Indian Curry, Ham, Salmon, Noodles, Baked Pasta, and Italian Ice-Cream. If your country is not covered by the above perhaps you might consider making a dish, we also need desserts and nibbles [i.e. prawn crackers etc.]

We need enough of each dish to serve 10 or more people, perhaps 2 or 3 people could cook the same dish. We would like people to volunteer to co-ordinate the food. Please complete the food sheet form at the back for the Church.

Then post these forms into the box provided, we would be most grateful. **Please, do not leave completed forms with your details on the table.**]
