# THEME: God Raised Him On High.



Today's feast of the Exaltation of the Cross reminds us that Christians live under the sign of the cross. It is by the cross that Jesus brought us forgiveness and life. On the cross he passed through suffering, gave it meaning and overcame it by making it a way to life. God has created us for happiness, and yet we know that life is marked with a cross. Even after his resurrection Jesus bore the scars of his wounds. Our wounds and pains, too, can be bearers of life if we offer them with Jesus so that others might live and be free.

**MEDITATE:** In suffering we grow in solidarity with Christ and with those he loves.

**ACT**: Can I see God touching and meeting me in suffering?
