

This weekend our retiring collection will be in support of the Priests Training Fund, which benefits the parishes and the Diocese of Westminster by providing us with new priests. The formation of our priests is of top priority - it is our future. The Priests Training Fund pays for the training and education of seminarians at our seminary, Allen Hall. There are currently 49 men studying at Allen Hall seminary, 13 of whom are from our own Diocese, We also have one seminarian in Valladolid and one at the Beda, presently on pastoral placement in Ruislip. It costs on average £25,000 per man, per year

of formation - that is about £150,000 to form and educate a new priest, who makes a lifetime commitment to Christ and the Church. This fund also supports the ongoing enrichment and formation of our ordained priests. Donation envelopes are available at each exit of the church.
