THEME: **Leading the Church**



Today we celebrate not only the feast of two great apostles of the Church, Peter and Paul, but also our own belonging and fidelity to the Church which they stand for. We build on Peter, the rock of faith and the rallying point of unity in the Church. With Paul, we are part of a missionary Church which wants to make Christ known to all the world. And so our prayer and offering today ask for firmness in the faith, for loyalty to the Church, and for the missionary zeal to make Christ known to everyone, and to unite all in him.

MEDITATE: As Christians we need to answer the same question that Jesus posed his disciples: "Who do people think Jesus is?" And who do I think Jesus is?

ACT: Our faith grows in as much as we profess it. Take some time to think about the words of the Creed and then recite slowly.
