MEDITATE: Eucharist means "thanksgiving". The Eucharist was and still is the operative action that identifies, unifies and sends out all Christians on mission for others.

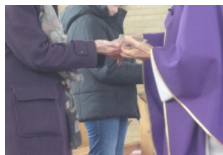
ACT: Reflect prayerfully on how you are Eucharist to others. ["Believe what you receive. Receive what you believe. Become what you receive." St. Augustine]
