# **THEME: Conscious Discipleship**



At first sight it looks contradictory that on the one hand Jesus presents his message and even himself as an invitation, a free offer that we can either accept or reject; and on the other hand as a strict demand. Today's gospel sheds light on this paradox: Yes, what he offers us is a present, and no one is forced to accept it. We remain free, but if we accept it, it will be demanding, Jesus and his kingdom are to be put above even our dearest relationships and desires. So,

we have to think twice before we accept. But we must know that with him and by his strength we can answer his call, however difficult, and we will be happy.

<u>MEDITATE:</u> Today's gospel serves as just one more wake-up call in a series of such calls we have heard these past weeks.

<u>ACT</u>: In what concrete way does this gospel invite me to carry the cross?

Scaffolding is also in place in the Car Park and in the Nursery Garden so a section of the Car Park is cornered off.

#### **LIVE STREAMING 24/7 - FOR YOUR AWARENESS**


