THEME: You Are the Temple.



We are glad that we can come to this church of brick and mortar and meet the Lord here in prayer. But we ourselves are living stones in the church of Christ our Lord, whose body we are. The Book of Revelation says: "Here God lives among his people. He lives among them and he will be their God, God-with-them." This is said about us, God's people! We are that temple in whom God

lives, both as members of Jesus' body and as a living Christian community. Through our Lord Jesus let us give thanks to God.


